



PRESENTATION BY THE ELECTIONS PANEL DELIVERED ON
THURSDAY, 20TH AUGUST 2020 DURING THE IQSK
SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING



The Panel

- The IQSK Elections Panel was commissioned by the IQSK Council (2018 – 2020) to oversee the 2020 IQSK elections.
- The Panel was constituted as follows:
 1. **Qs. Rasugu Nyamboki**
 2. **Qs. Dr. Isabella Njeri Wachira – Towey**
 3. **Ernest Nyakundi (Graduate Qs.)**
- Since the 6th of August, the Elections Panel has run its affairs with the help of the IQSK Secretariat and Dennis Milgo from ICPAK to deliver on its mandate; all in line with stipulations of the IQSK Constitution and By-Laws 2013.



Nominations

- On the 27th of July 2020, an elections notice was issued by the IQSK Hon. Secretary, Qs. Mutinda Mutuku.
- Alongside the notice, was a call for the nomination of aspiring candidates. This call ran for two weeks ending on the 7th of August 2020.
- At the end of the nominations call, the panel received a total of 14 applications for nominations.
- The panel, assisted by the IQSK Secretariat, proceeded to vet the applicants in order to ensure that they had met all conditions for successful nomination.
- All the 14 applicants were successfully nominated and the next slides show the nominees and the positions that they had applied for.

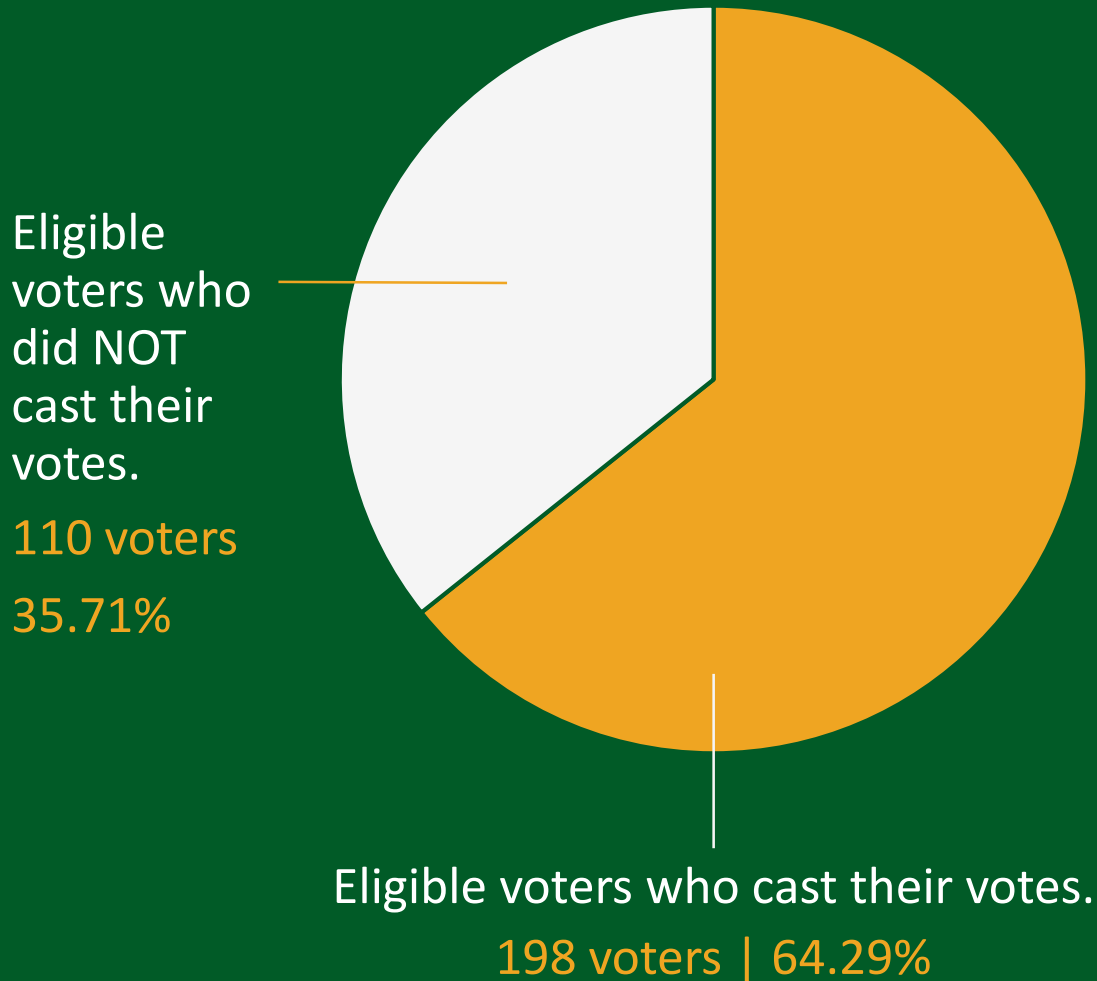

Election Results for the Positions of IQSK Council Members

- There were 308 members in the final voters' register. A total of 198 members voted in the election to decide the next IQSK Council Members.
- It is important to note that unlike the previous two contested positions of IQSK Vice President and IQSK Assistant Honorary Secretary, while electing IQSK Council Members, members were supposed to choose four (4) of their preferred candidates for the positions of IQSK Council Members. This is how members voted.
 - 178 members settled on four candidates of their choice to serve as council members effectively filling up all allowable positions.
 - 14 members voted for one of the candidates and proceeded to abstain on three of the four allowable votes for council members.
 - 1 member voted for two of the candidates and proceeded to abstain on two of the four allowable slots for council members.
 - 5 members voted for three of the candidates and proceeded to abstain on one of the four allowable slots for council members.
- This is how the candidates for the position performed.
