PRESENTATION BY THE INDEPENDENT ELECTIONS COMMISSION
DELIVERED ON FRIDAY, 31ST MAY 2024 DURING THE IQSK
ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING



The Commission

- The 2024 Independent Elections Commission of IQSK was appointed on the 26th of April 2024 and was constituted as follows:
 1. Qs. Francis King'ori – Chairperson
 2. Qs. Gladys Wahome – Vice Chairperson
 3. Qs. Japheth Kibet – Commissioner
 4. Qs. Portia Kabau – Commissioner
 5. Ernest Nyakundi – Commissioner
- Since the 26th of April 2024, the Elections Commission has run its affairs with the help of the IQSK Secretariat to deliver on its mandate; as stipulated in the IQSK Constitution and By-Laws 2013 and, more specifically, By-Law 17 which contains the Rules and Regulations Governing the IQSK Council Elections.



Elections Notice and Nominations

- On Thursday, 2nd of May 2024, an Elections Notice was issued by the Commission.
- Alongside the Elections Notice, was a Call for the Nomination of aspiring candidates.
- The application for nomination was for one week up to Thursday, 9th of May 2024.
- At the end of the nomination period, the Commission had received a total of 21 applications.
- The Commission, assisted by the IQSK Secretariat, proceeded to vet the applicants in order to ensure that they had met all conditions for successful nomination.
- Nineteen (19) applicants were successful and were included in the Draft Nominations List while two (2) were not cleared by the Commission.

Nominations (Cont'd)

- The Commission published the Draft Nominations List on Friday, 10th of May 2024 and provided a window for the receipt of appeals arising from the Nominations Process.
- This window ran for one week and lapsed on Thursday, 16th May 2024.
- At the end of the Appeals window, the Commission had received two appeals.
- The Commission considered the appeals and cleared one of the appellants.
- The Commission then published a list of successfully nominated Candidates on the IQSK Elections Website; signaling the Start of the Official Campaign Period on Friday, 17th of May 2024.

Voters' Register

- The Commission compiled and published a Draft Voters' Register on 15th of May 2023.
- Members were then invited to verify their inclusion in the Voters' Register on a Voter Verification Portal.
- The verification process ended on Thursday, 23rd of May 2024.
- At the end of the verification process, the Voters' Register had a total of 393 eligible voters.
- This was the highest number of eligible voters in the history of the Institute.
- Nonetheless, the Commission noted that the 393 members were still less than half of all the full members of the Institute.



Stakeholders' Engagement

- The Commission, in response to a number of concerns raised about the IQSK Elections System, convened a Stakeholders' Engagement Forum on Friday, 24th May 2024.
- At the end of the forum, the Commission resolved to engage an Independent Service Provider to satisfy all players.
- After considering four providers, the Commission settled on CnR Group to be the provider of the elections system for the 2024 IQSK Council Elections.



Voter Sensitization Webinar

- The Commission conducted a Voter Sensitization Webinar on Wednesday, 29th May 2024.
- This Webinar was attended by the General Membership of the Institute.
- During the webinar, members in attendance were taken through various topics, namely:
 1. The significance of every vote
 2. How to verify voter registration
 3. The Elections System
 4. Tips for a smooth voting experience
- Afterwards, the webinar's presentation was circulated to the general membership of the Institute.

CONTESTED POSITIONS

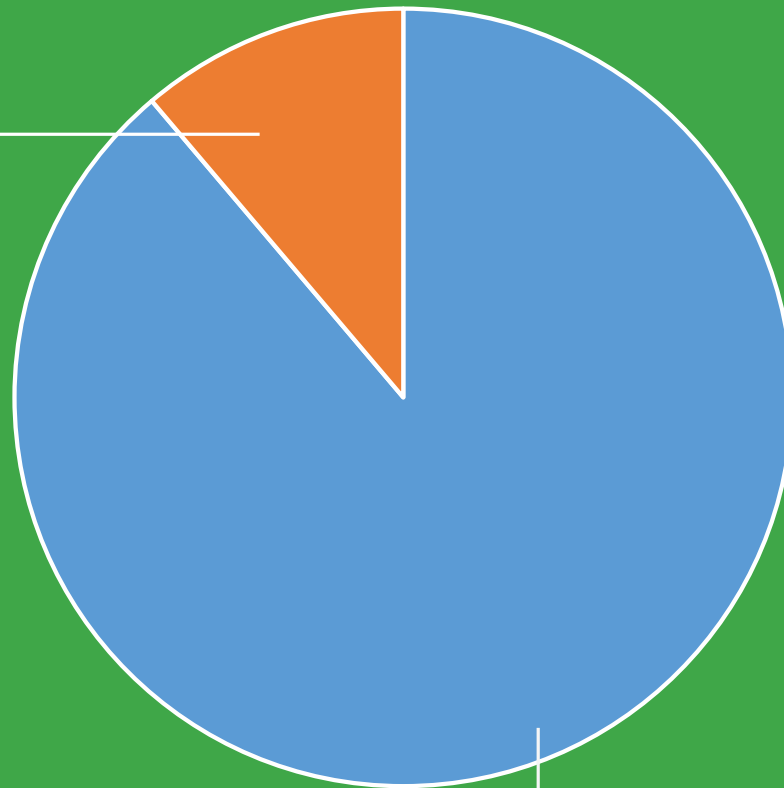
Contested Positions; Elected after Balloting

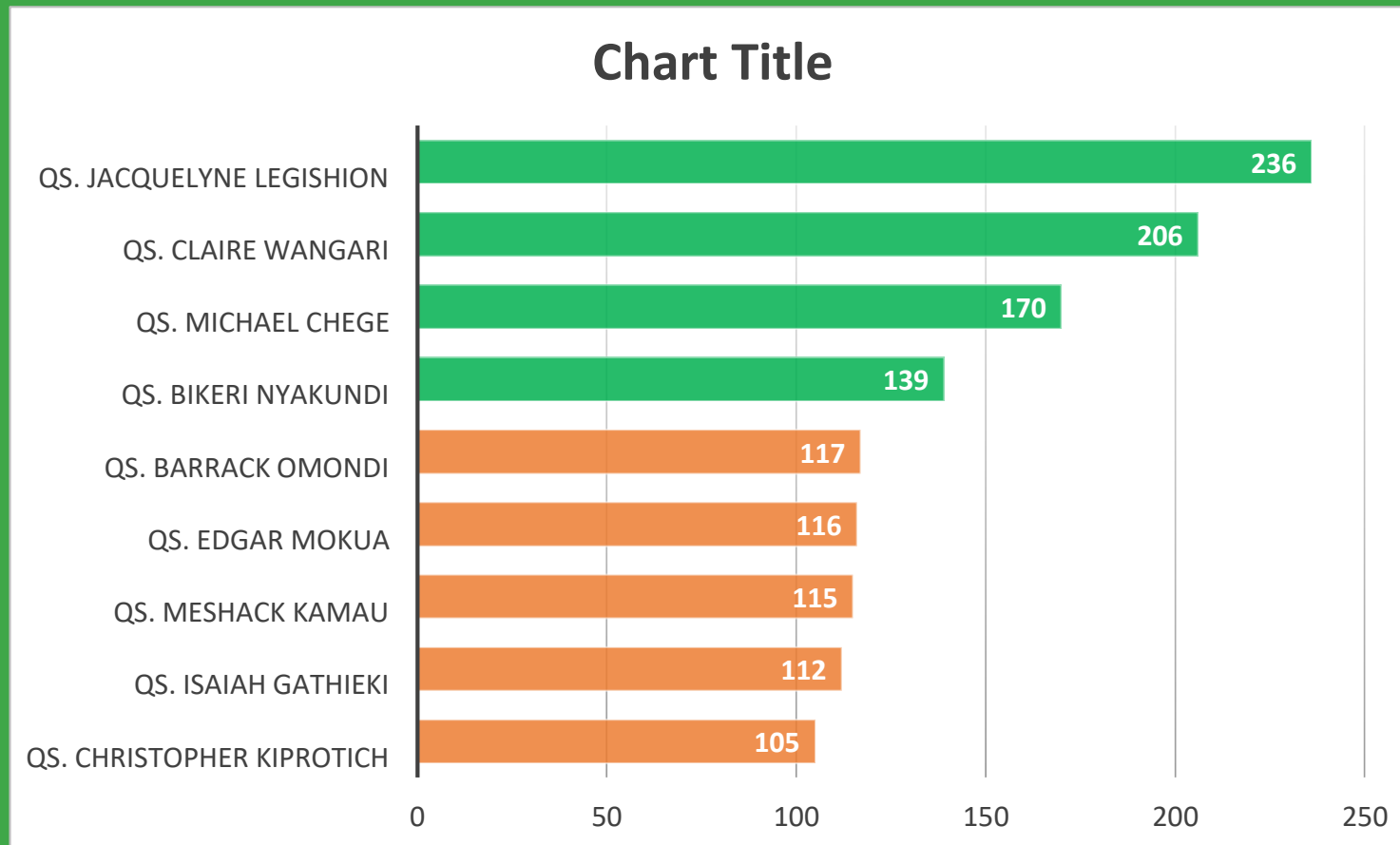
